Grammar

The simple present tense is used to express habits and routines, general truths, repeated actions or unchanging situations, emotions and wishes.

- I smoke (habit)
- I work in London (unchanging situation)
- London is a large city (general truth)

We use adverbs of frequency with the present simple to say "How often" we do something. (Always, Usually, Often, Sometimes, Never)

- I often go to the cinema.
- She usually drinks coffee.
- She sometimes visits me at home.

Note: In simple present tense, we add the suffix -s at the end of the verbs for the third-person singular noun or pronoun (He, She, It, Sara, Boat ... etc.). On the other hand, verbs with plural nouns and pronouns do not add "s" at the end.
