-Verbs that end in -y (play/stay...) → simply add -ing

Note:

Vowels: a, e, i, o, u

Consonants: b, c, d, f, g, h, j, k, l, m, n, p, q, r, s, t, v, w, x, y, z

- things that are temporary or are happening now or around now.
- What is happening in a picture or paragraph.
- fixed future plans.

<p>We use: Subject+ (is /are/am) + "ing" verb</p> <p>-They are singing. -we are cooking. -you are smiling. -She is talking -He is laughing -It is raining. -I am walking</p>	<p>We use: Subject+(is/are/am) + "ing" verb</p> <p>-They are not singing. (aren't) -We are not cooking. (aren't) -You are not smiling. (aren't) -She is not talking. (isn't) -He is not laughing. (isn't) -It is not raining. (isn't) -I am not walking.</p>	<p>We use: (Is/Are/Am) +Subject" Ing" verb?</p> <p>-Are they singing? -Are we cooking? -Are you smiling? -Is she talking? -Is he laughing? -Is it raining? -Am I walking?</p>

Spelling Rules

Verbs that end in -e (make/ write etc.) → Drop the -e and add -ing
 make: making write: writing drive: driving

Verbs that end in a vowel+ a consonant (get, run...) → double the consonant then add "ing".
 get: Getting Run: running swim: swimming

Do not double the letter if the verb ends in -w or -x or -y
 snow: snowing fix: fixing buy: buying
