Present simple:

Time expressions:

We use the following expressions with the present simple:

Adverbs of frequency, every day, at the weekend, in the morning, on Mondays, in January, on Friday evenings, twice a week, once a month, etc.

Present continuous:

Time expressions:

We often use the following time expressions with the present continuous:

Now, at the moment, for the time being, these days, at present, this week, today, tonight ...)

Note: check previous worksheets for more details.

Note: In the third person singular (he, she, it) we add -s, -es, -ies to the simple present verb.

For most verbs simply add s.

Like: likes

read: reads

cost: costs

We add -es when the basic verb form ends in -ch, -sh or -ss.

Wash: washes

watch: watches

Pass: passes

With some verbs ending in -y, we change the 'y' to -ies.

Fly: flies

try: tries

study: studies



Be careful!

When a verb ends in -ay, -uy, -oy or ey, the 'y' doesn't change to i:

Play: plays

buy: buys

enjoy: enjoys
