A complete sentence consists of :

- Subject + Predicate
- Tells **who** or **what** the sentence is about. Tells what the subject does or is.

Example :

Mary



went to the shop.



The subject can be noun – proper noun- pronoun

The predicate must begin with a verb.

Example :

The **Bunny** (noun)



eats the carrot.

- **Superman** (proper noun)



flies over town.
