What Is Active Voice?

Active voice is a way of writing sentences where the **subject** (the person, animal, or thing the sentence is about) is the one **doing the action**.

It makes writing clear, strong, and easy to understand.

Mow Active Voice Works

A sentence in active voice almost always follows this pattern:

Subject + Verb (action) + Object

Subject \rightarrow who is doing the action

Verb \rightarrow the action

Object \rightarrow who or what receives the action

Example:

The boy (subject) kicked (verb) the ball (object).

The boy is doing the action, so the sentence is active.

Why We Use Active Voice

Active voice helps:

Make sentences **stronger**

Make writing easier to read

Show clearly who is doing what

Writers use active voice to make their ideas more direct and interesting.

More Examples

1-The students solved the problem.

(Students are doing the solving.)

2-The cat caught the mouse.

(Cat is doing the catching.)

3-My mom baked a cake.

(Mom is doing the baking.)

Mow to Check If a Sentence Is Active

Ask these questions:

- 1. Who is doing the action?
- 2. Is the subject doing the action?

If yes \rightarrow **Active voice**

If no \rightarrow It's probably passive voice

Example:

The chef cooked dinner.

Who cooked? \rightarrow The chef (subject).

Is the chef doing the action? \rightarrow Yes! Active voice.

✓ Quick Formula

Passive:

Object + was/were + past participle + by + subject

Active:

Subject + verb + object

Another Example

Passive:

The window was broken by the boy.

Active:

The boy broke the window.
