Math	•Objective: Practice subtraction problems within 5. •Activity: Give students simple subtraction problems (e.g., $4 - 1$, $3 - 2$) and have them use objects (like blocks or counters) to physically remove the items and count the result. Focus on helping them understand the relationship between numbers.		•Objective: Apply subtraction in story problems. •Activity: Read simple subtraction word problems (e.g., "There are 5 birds on a tree. 2 fly away. How many are left?"). Have students draw or use objects to solve the problems. Focus on helping them understand the situation and how subtraction applies.	•Objective: Practice subtraction problems within 7. •Activity: Provide problems like $7 - 3$, $6 - 4$, etc. Let students use objects or draw pictures to show the subtraction process. Reinforce the idea of taking away and counting what remains.	•Objective: Practice subtraction using visual aids (pictures, counters, etc.). •Activity: Give students worksheets with pictures of objects (like apples or stars). Have them subtract a number from the total and circle the remaining items. For example, "There are 8 stars, and 3 fly away. How many are left?"
